

**ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
OF THE CITY OF FLOWOOD, MISSISSIPPI
REGULATING THE USE OF CRYSTAL LAKE PARK**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have acquired land and constructed Crystal Lake Park with picnic areas, restrooms, boat ramps and other amenities; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen desire to adopt regulations to govern the use of said park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Flowood as follows:

SECTION 1: DEFINITIONS

1. "Park" means the Crystal Lake Park area located between Casey Lane and Crystal Lake as well as the entire body of water known as Crystal Lake.
2. "City" means the City of Flowood, Mississippi.

SECTION 2: UNLAWFUL ACTS

It shall be unlawful within the park to do any of the following acts:

- (a) Enter the park area or Crystal Lake except between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
- (b) Possess, consume, give or purchase alcoholic beverages on park property.
- (c) Camp in the park.
- (d) Hunt any game in the park.
- (e) Ski or operate a jet ski within Crystal Lake.
- (f) Swim in Crystal Lake.
- (g) Park except in designated areas only.
- (h) Litter the park with trash or other debris.
- (i) Exceed 20 miles per hour while operating a motor vehicle on park property.
- (j) Park any motor vehicle which blocks or limits access to the boat loading ramp, public restrooms or picnic areas or other motor vehicles.
- (k) To operate a motor boat or other motor vessel within fifty (50) feet of the boat loading ram so as to cause a wake.
- (l) Possess, fire or operate any pistol, rifle or shotgun within the park.
- (m) Fish at the park area without a valid fishing license.
- (n) Solicit or peddle any service or item within the park.
- (o) Create any unreasonable loud, disturbing or unnecessary noise within the park area.
- (p) Operate any loud speaker, amplifier, radio or television set so as to disturb the quiet, comfort and repose of the persons using the park.

SECTION 3: WILDLIFE PARK AND FISH REGULATIONS

All regulations promulgated by the Mississippi Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks Department relating to fishing and boating and use of park areas are hereby incorporated herein by reference and to the extent that these regulations conflict with any of those regulations, if any, the strictest regulation shall apply.

SECTIONS 4: PENALTIES

Any person violating any portion of these regulations shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and may be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisoned for not more than fifteen (15) days, or both such fine and imprisonment as determined by the Court.
